For the summer of 2010, the Tucson Chapter of Amigos de las Américas will supplement the benefits you receive if you are accepted to serve on the IO project staff team.

This program is in response to feedback we've received that many vets would like to move up the Amigos Leadership ladder and participate as project staff, but are unable to do so because of the need to earn some money. The Tucson chapter wants to do everything possible to encourage our highly successful volunteers to stay involved in the program and reap the benefits of climbing the leadership ladder in Amigos!

The requirements to participate in this program are:

1. Be a Tucson chapter veteran in good standing with the chapter
2. Be approved by the Tucson Chapter Board
3. Be accepted by IO for project staff
4. Attend and assist in Tucson Chapter Vol training (if possible)
5. Attend Tucson Chapter Staff training (if possible)
6. Complete a successful project as a staff person (as determined by IO)

The following payment schedule will be followed by the Tucson Chapter:

Sr. Project Supervisor	Expenses + \$ 500	\$1,250

Project Director	Expenses + \$2,250	\$2,000

You can find the project staff applications at the IO website, www.amigoslink.org. Senior Staff applications are generally due in mid-October and Project Supervisor applications are due by mid-November. Please see the IO website for specifics.

If you're interested in participating as a staff person, please contact the Training Director or the Board President no later than 1 week prior to the IO deadlines. We will arrange for a Board interview so you will know your acceptance in the program.

Your stipend will be paid at the end of your summer after successful completion of your project. To be paid, you must submit a written project experience report and request for payment to the Tucson Board President.
